STORAGE OF BUDERUS SOLAR COLLECTORS ON SITE

When storing Solar Collectors on site prior to installation, various points must be taken into consideration and some points **must** be adhered to.

- Only store collectors in dry conditions and preferably on the side edge of the panel.
- If storing the collectors for any period of time in the open, ensure the collectors are covered with a tarpaulin which protects from both direct sunlight and rain.

Please remember if the solar collectors are left uncovered in the open and exposed to solar radiation for even small amounts of time, they may cause burns to unprotected skin when touching the solar collector.
